

Using Skill Tracker - A sample skill logging scenario



MYP 1: General Science Class

Activity: Learning how to structure a lab report. The teacher has just demonstrated the process for the students.

Log the skill: The teacher reminds students that now is an opportunity to log the demonstration as an ATL skill. Students can also use *Skill Tracker* to record the steps in the process. They can then refer to this when having to write a lab report at the end of the unit.

How does the student do this? The example below shows the process a student will go through to log the skill using *Skill Tracker*

1. Choose your class from the drop down list
2. Describe the activity or task where you were working on an ATL skill eg 'Writing a lab report'
3. Choose the appropriate ATL category from the dropdown list. You can ask your teacher if you're not sure
4. Choose the appropriate ATL cluster. You can ask your teacher if you're not sure.
5. Choose the skill level for the task. Click on the ⓘ if you're not sure.
6. Add some more information or a reflection or a reminder about the skill
7. Upload an attachment that is evidence of your ATL skill eg a photo
8. Click 'submit' and the skill is added to your Work Overview.
