What are some of your favourite subjects at school? What makes you smile?

Sports, crafts, animals, gaming, the environment, entrepreneurship, music, adventures, theatre, dance, cooking,

Skills

What is something that you have learned how to do?

Collaboration, active listening, time management, communication, interview skills, leading a team, supporting others

Areas for growth

What would you like to learn or be able to do or be a part of?

Learn a new skill, understand more about an issue, connect with a certain community group, extend your class learning, set a goal
